

# EDITOR ABBOTT The TOURIST

**Sees Major Washington Inaugurated, Inspects Battalion and Dines with President Frissell at Hampton—Is Guest of Defender Agent at Atlantic City and of Editor Anderson in Gotham.**

Hampton, Va., May 26.—Editor Robert S. Abbott, sole owner and editor of the world's greatest weekly, was the guest of Dr. and Mrs. Frissell at dinner Sunday. Monday was spent renewing his acquaintance with his former classmates, who came back to the annual commencement exercises. Monday an elaborate dinner was served in honor of Hampton's former student who now controls the greatest paper of the Race. George Garner, noted tenor; Mme. Cole-Talbert and Mme. Tapley were also guests. The editor visited the surrounding towns and left for Washington Tuesday evening.

Washington, D. C., May 26.—Editor Abbott arrived here Wednesday morning and was met by a delegation of friends. A visit to the capitol grounds, and other places of interest preceded an interview with Congressman Madden. The afternoon was spent among the elite of the capital.
