The Bahais of America, who are building a great universal house of worship at Wilmette, the doors of which will be open to all races, seets and religious, will meet for their 15th annual convention at the Auditorium hotel, April 28 to May 1.

The public sessions will be held Sunday, April 29, at 3 p. m., and Monday and Tuesday evenings at 3 o'clock in the banquet room of the hotel.
