BAHAIS HOLD CONGRESS

The Bahai congress, devoted to the principles of world peace, religious unity and racial accord, will hold a two-day meeting here, the first to take place Feb. 23, at the Free synagogue, 40 W. 68th St., at 3 p. m. "The Oneness of Humanity," will be discussed by Rabbi Stephen S. Wise and Mountfort Mills. Hooper Harris will act as chairman. At 8 p. m., the congress will meet at Bethel A. M. E. church, the Rev.
