NEW YORK CITY, April 30.—Mrs. Cecelia Cabanise-Saunders, executive secretary of the 137th street YWCA, New York City, was elected as alumni representative on the board of trustees of Fisk university during a recent meeting at Fisk.

Mrs. Saunders will fill the place on the trustee board made vacant by the death of Mrs. M. L. Crosthwaite of Detroit.

Mrs. Saunders, a graduate of Fisk university, has gained the reputation of being one of the country's keenest executives, operating at a financial profit one of the largest YWCA units to be found anywhere else in the United States.
