## Dr. A. Locke Appointed To Survey Graphic Staff

NEW YORK—Dr. Alain Locke, special editor of the November issue of Survey Graphic entitled, "Color: Unfinished Business of Democracy," has been named to the editorial board of the famous publication. Dr. Locke will serve as a contributing editor.

The appointment of the noted Howard university professor came as "recognition of his successful editing of the issue," said an announcement. The November number was the seventh in a series of special editions entitled "Calling America."
