

# Movie Slated At Baha'i House Dec. 30

— A special program, "Carmel, the Mountain of God," will be featured Sunday, Dec. 24, 3 p.m. at the Baha'i House of Worship, Sheridan Road and Linden Avenue, in Wilmette.

On and near Mount Carmel, in the Holy Land, are located the spiritual and administrative centers of the Baha'is of the world. Baha'u'llah, the prophet-founder of the Baha'i Faith, designated Carmel to be "the seat of My throne" when He walked there in the last years of His life.

The program of pictures, narration and music is intended to show the beauty and the significance of the mountain, its shrines and gardens, and the holy places nearby.

This is one of a weekly series of meetings at the Baha'i House of Worship Sundays at 3:45 p.m., following the 3 p.m. devotions. After the program an informal "fire-side" discussion will be open to all.
