# **David Kellum U.N. Day speaker here Sunday**

A public program for United Nations Day, Sunday, Oct. 24, is being presented by the Baha'i Community of Chicago at the Baha'i Center, 116 S. Michigan, at 1 p.m.

Speaker for the event will be David Kellum, former city editor of The Daily Defender.

Kellum will speak on the theme for this year's Baha'i observance of United Nations Day "Justice The

Basis of Unity."

This year has been designated by the United Nations as the International Year for Action to Combat Racism and Racial Discrimination. In calling attention to the Year, U Thant, Secretary General of the United Nations said:
