

Baha'i info chief moves to Hawaii

WILMETTE, Ill. — Col. Salvatore A. Pele, presently National Public Information Officer for the U. S. Baha'i Community has moved to Honolulu, Hawaii with his family. They left recently for Hawaii by way of Europe, the Holy Land and Asia on a two-and-one-half month teaching trip for the Baha'i Faith.

In Hawaii, the Pelles will reside in Kaneohe on the Island of Oahu.

Pelle served as a director of Information for the U. S. Air Force for 24 years. He retired from military service in February, 1968 with the rank of Colonel.
