"The inscription is composed of two 'Ba' and four 'Ha.' The explanation of "Ba" has been written in the commentary upon 'Bism'illah' 'errahman, errahin'; it is very detailed, and is not suitable for this letter; you must refer to the commentary.

The repetition of the 'Ba' refers to the invisibility and to the Presence. (X)

It is because of this that upon the stone of the Nohle ring, the "Bs" has been combined with the "Ms" and in the same way the Greatest Name appears in the inscription, for the number is 9. If you multiply 9 which is the number of Baha with that of the Bab, which is 5, that makes 9 times 5 which is 45. And in the same way if you multiply 5 which is the number of the Bab with 9 which is the number of Baha, that makes 45, and this number is equal to the number of Adam (XXX). Similarly if you add together (the units) of 9, that makes 45; 1 plus 2 equals 3; 3 plus 3 equals 6; 6 plus 4 equals 10; 10 plus 5 equals 15; 15 plus 6 equals 21; 21 plus 7 equals 28; 28 plus 8 equals 35; 36 plus 9 equals 45. If now you add together the units of the number of the Bab (1.e. 5) that makes 15; 1 plus 2 equals 3; 3 plus 3 equals 6; 6 plus 5 equals 3; 3 plus 3 equals 10; 10 plus 5 equals 15 which is equal/ to the number of Eve. (XXXX) and is in conformity with the Hadiss 'I and Ali, we are the Father and Mother of this people.'

Hadiss 'I and Ali, we are the Father and Mother of this people.' 'Adam' signifies the overflowing Reality, distributive, active, which represents the appe aranes of the Names and Realities of COD, and the divine conditions (or Stations); whereas Eve is the passive Reality, taking, dependent, receptive, existing through the divine Name and Qualities. Bruefly such are the least of the Mysteries of the composition of the Greatest Name upon the stone of the Divine ring.

Briefly, the true 'Ba' which is the universal mality, once doscended and distributed into the third degree from the Supreme rank, to the inferior creature, becomes the collector and creator of all worlds.

Upon the horizon of sternal glory two luminous stars have arisen brilliantly; one to the right and one to the left. This Supreme Mystery is the two diagrams placed to the left and to the right of the Greatest Name upon the stone of the goble ring, this is the Mystery of the appearance of the Beauty of ABHA and of the Supreme Highness. What is the meaning of the image and likeness of God? It means that man will bedome the manifestor of the names and attributes of the Deity; it means that-all the perfections and luminosities of the Divine will shine upon the mirror of human beings Man is like unto iron, and the Bounties of the Divine are like unto fire. When the iron is placed in the fire, all its iron qualities become hidden and the qualities of the fire become manifest. The iron was first heated by being put in the fire. It becomes hot. It was black, it becomes like fire. It was solid, it becomes liquid, fluid. These are the qualities of the fire. When the qualities become manifest in the iron, the iron will assume the very forn and likeness of the fire. Likewise as to the reality of man, when he forgets himself, and the Divine Names and Attributes become manifest in him, then he will become the very image and likeness of God. We hope that all you who have turned towards the Kingdom of Abha will endeavor so that you may be first illumined yourselves, that is take on the qualities of the Divine Fire, become embodiments of the Divine Heat, and then be the cause of others taking on the same qualities with which you have become endowed, so that they too may become the very image and likeness of God.
